(enter the angel Gabriel and the Virgin Mary)

Read Luke 1:26-29, 46-47

26 And in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God unto a city of Galilee, named Nazareth,

27 To a virgin espoused to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David; and the virgin's name was Mary.

- **28** And the angel came in unto her, and said, Hail, thou that art highly favoured, the Lord is with thee: blessed art thou among women.
- **29** And when she saw him, she was troubled at his saying, and cast in her mind what manner of salutation this should be.
- **30** And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found favour with God.
- **31** And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS.
- **32** He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David:
- **33** And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end.
- **34** Then said Mary unto the angel, How shall this be, seeing I know not a man?
- **35** And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God.
- **46** And Mary said, My soul doth magnify the Lord.
- **47** And my spirit hath rejoiced in God my Saviour.

(exit Mary. Enter Joseph. Angel Gabriel remains.)

Read Matthew 1:19-21

- **19** Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not willing to make her a public example, was minded to put her away privily.
- **20** But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost.
- **21** And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.

(Exit Joseph and Angel Gabriel)

Read Matthew 18:22-23

- **22** Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the lord by the prophet, saying,
- **23** Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.

SING: Third Verse of Oh Come All Ye Faithful

Read *Luke 2:1, 3-5*

- **1** AND it came to pass in those days, that there went out a decree from Caesar Augustus, that all the world should be taxed.
- **3** And all went to be taxed, everyone into his own city.
- **4** And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judaea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem; (because he was of the house and lineage of David:)

5 To be taxed with Mary his espoused wife, being great with child.

(enter donkey, Mary, and Joseph in the stable)

Read Luke 2:6-7

- **6** And so it was, that, while they were there, the days were accomplished that she should be delivered.
- **7** And she brought forth her firstborn son, and wrapped him in swaddling clothes, and laid him in a manger; because there was no room for them in the inn. (Mary brings out baby Jesus)

SING Away in a Manger

(Enter in away from the stable scene the shepherds, sheep, and angel)

Read Luke 2:8-12

- **8** And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night.
- **9** And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid.
- **10** And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people.
- 11 For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord.
- **12** And this shall be a sign unto you; Ye shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger.

(enter the heavenly host)

Read Luke 2:13-14

13 And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying,

14 Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.

(Shepherds and sheep go to manger scene)

READ Luke 2:16-19

16 And they came with haste, and found Mary, and Joseph, and the babe lying in a manger.

17 And when they had seen it, they made known abroad the saying which was told them concerning this child.

18 And all they that heard it wondered at those things which were told them by the shepherds.

19 But Mary kept all these things, and pondered them in her heart.
